# August 18, 2013

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**Pre-Session: Area is raised**

**Itch Intensity: 7-10/10, scratching does not really relieve**

**Frequency: Constant since initial sting**

**Post-90 min. Session: Area is less raised and reduced in size**

**Itch Intensity: 0/10**

**Frequency: TBD**



**Scale: 0 = No itch – 10 = “just cut it off for relief”**

# September 9, 2013

**Pre-Session: Sting site raised**

**Itch Intensity: 4-6/10, scratch for some relief**

**Frequency: Occasional through out each day, since first session**

**Post-90 min. Session: Sting site raised, yet reduced**

**Itch Intensity: 0/10**

**Frequency: TBD**



**Scale: 0 = No itch – 10 = “just cut it off for relief”**

# October 21, 2013

**Pre-Session: Sting site smaller yet raised**  
**Itch Intensity: 7/10, scratching relieves**  
**Frequency: Once every 1-2 days**



**Post-90 min. Session: Sting site even smaller than start and almost not raised**  
**Itch Intensity: 0/10**  
**Frequency: TBD**



**Scale: 0 = No itch – 10 = “just cut it off for relief”**
